- A motion was by Supervisor Hoy to approve the Consent Agenda as presented, second by Supervisor McCoy, MCU

Road Master report by Brian Hoy:

- Snow is hopefully finished for the year. All snow plow equipment has been removed from the trucks.
- The roads & municipal building have both been cleared of debris from the wind and blown clear.

Road inspection:

- A meeting with Seth regarding cleaning the ditches and seal coating was held on Monday and he will be giving us an estimate
- Queen’s Run Road ditches are cleared and will need some minor repairs.
- A motion was presented by Supervisor Hoy to purchase gravel for the road from Range Resources, 10 tons 2A stone and Benson will spread the materials, second by Chairman Mann, MCU. An estimate was requested from Heidelberg Materials for pricing.
- Speed limit signs need to be posted.
- Hollow Road pipes need to be cleaned out and scratch coated, estimated cost is \$76,796. We will put out for bid in June/July.
- Old Pike Road needs to be graded and reshaped
- Pine Creek Township will bring their sweeper truck to clean Hollow Road.

NRAT Committee:

- The Township has paid its \$600 membership fee which is for three years.
- Jeff Snyder is taking the lead for Clinton County on trying to get things set up, finalize a budget so a secretary can be hired and hire someone to design a website.
- We have not received any notice from the State in regards to turning of permit fees.
- Gallagher Township will put a link on our website to direct people to NRAT once it is established and to post our ATV Ordinance.

Public Comment:

- Aaron Stephens states that the work that has been done on Queen's Run Road/Rt. 664 to Leisure Acres is great. There are still issues with people speeding which needs to be addressed.
 - Supervisors suggested that we install signage for "Hidden Driveway", "Pedestrians" or "Children at Play" to make people aware and to follow the speed limit.
- Bobby Maguire stated that he is beginning work on the subdivision located near Carrier, Oak ridge, Farrington & Old Pike Roads and would be providing the Township documents to review the conditions once finalized.
- Bobby Maguire also thanked and congratulated the Township for its Agenda transparency and said it was great to see.
- A letter was provided to the Township from the Haneyville Volunteer Fire Company showing the breakdown for the \$10k donation provided by the Township.

Old Business:**Zoning & Code Enforcement Officer Update:****Update on Church Road Project:**

- A motion was presented by Supervisor Hoy recommending a revision to our multi-modal grant application, lowering the job cost and limiting the scope of work to smaller sections of roads in order to increase our chances of funding. A second was presented by Supervisor McCoy, MCU.
- A suggestion to contact Chris Dush & Stephanie Borowicz to assist with application process was discussed.

New Business**ATV Signs**

- Todd Pfeiffer – ATV Trail Start & Trail End signage needs to be installed along with sign posts.

Grading Old Pike

- Parts of Old Pike Road are washed away and vegetation needs to be cleared and the roadway needs to be graded and rolled. Benson estimate includes 10 loads of stone at \$13,150. The Township will haul off the vegetation and clear the ditches. A motion to approve the project was presented by Supervisor Hoy, seconded by Supervisor McCoy, MCU.

Church Rd / Queens Run / Hollow Rd pipes and ditches:

- The ditches and pipes need cleared on Church Road and the ditch line/shoulder needs to be lined with R rock. Benson provided an estimate in the amount of \$7975. A motion to approve was presented by Chairman Mann, seconded by Supervisor Hoy, MCU.

Renew 3rd party auditor

- A motion to approve the optional extension for a township auditor was presented by Chairman Mann, seconded by Supervisor hoy, MCU.

Tax Collector Account

- Shelly & Becky discussed the Tax Collector account and Becky is going to contact FCCB about setting up a new account with the, and closing the old account from Jersey Shore State Bank because of the EIN # on the account still belongs to the previous auditor.

Bank

- A motion to contact FCCB, Journey Bank & Woodlands Bank to see what they have to offer the Township was presented by Supervisor Hoy, seconded by Chairman Mann, MCU. Shelly will contact all the banks and provide information at an upcoming meeting.
